- Problem Solving** - Add a problem solving question to the blog. Use

- Pupil profile** - interview one person in the classroom. Give us an overview of who they are and what makes them special.
- Maths matters** - tell us about something you have been learning this week in maths. Write the learning intension and a few examples of your work.
